

Petition to keep New South Wales free from uranium exploration and mining

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales. This petition of residents of New South Wales brings to the attention of the house:

Uranium mining presents risks to workers, local communities and the environment, and will leave a lasting radioactive legacy for future generations.

The uranium mining industry has a long history of leaks, safety breaches and failed mine rehabilitation. Transporting uranium for export places local residents and transport workers at risk. Uranium exported from NSW will contribute to the risk of nuclear disasters overseas and undermine global efforts to phase out nuclear weapons.

The undersigned petitioners therefore ask the Legislative Assembly, the NSW Premier, and the Minister for Resources and Energy to maintain the ban on uranium mining and to call on the government to hold an open and transparent inquiry into the impacts of uranium exploration and mining before exploration licences are issued in NSW.
